



Current Warm Homes **Local Grant partners** include:

























Connected For Warmth (CFW)

CFW is delivered in partnership with Affordable Warmth Solutions, Connected For Warmth (now in its 4th phase) shows how we can take a holistic approach to project design, by supporting a combination of energy efficiency funding routes.

- **⊘** Loft & cavity wall insulation: Delivered under ECO to 9000 homes
- **⊘** Air Source Heat Pumps (ASHPs) and energy bill support: Currently delivering under ECO with a target of **500 homes**
- **Soiler Upgrade Scheme (BUS):** Where residents may not meet eligibility, we can deliver 20% of targets via this scheme
- Over £25.4 million funding delivered

The Warmer Homes programme offers a range of fully funded energy measures to help households stay warm and reduce energy bills.

Long-time Test Valley residents Mr and Mrs Smith shared their experience of upgrading from an ageing oil boiler to a modern, renewable heating system powered by solar energy.

Discovering Warmer Homes

Mr and Mrs Smith had lived with the same oil boiler for 35 years. It was becoming increasingly costly to run and service, and its inefficiency was affecting their day-to-day comfort.





Some winters we even ran out of oil by accident and were left with a cold house until more arrived.
