Current Warm Homes Local Grant partners include:



Connected For Warmth (CFW)

We delivered Connected for Warmth in partnership with Affordable Warmth Solutions. The programme shows how we can take a holistic approach to project design, by supporting a combination of energy efficiency funding routes.

- ✔ **Loft & cavity wall insulation:** Delivered under ECO to **9000 homes**
- ✔ **Air Source Heat Pumps (ASHPs) and energy bill support:** Delivered under ECO with a target of **500 homes**
- ✔ **Boiler Upgrade Scheme (BUS):** Where residents did not meet eligibility, we could deliver 20% of targets via this scheme
- ✔ **Over £25.4 million funding** delivered

The **Warmer Homes programme** offers a range of **fully funded energy measures** to help households **stay warm and reduce energy bills.**


