Large scale retrofit delivery

✔ **Project Scale:** £23.8 million under Home Upgrade Grant: Phase 2 (HUG2)

✔ **Date:** April 2023 – March 2025

AgilityEco partnered with Warmer Homes, a consortium of 32 local authorities across the South and East of England led by Portsmouth City Council, to deliver large-scale home retrofit projects under the Home Upgrade Grant (HUG) scheme Phase 2.

The award-winning scheme provided eligible off-gas grid households with fully funded energy efficiency upgrades and low carbon heating, enabling residents to live in warmer, cheaper-to-heat homes.

We continue to partner with the consortium to deliver the **Warm Homes: Local Grant (WH:LG) programme** to low-income households across the region, having installed over £13.1m in upgrades in Year 1, with £8.2m secured for Year 2 to date.
